## About the rhyme

This rhyme is a word game in which two short words are put together to make a longer word.

## Activities

- Repeat the rhyme inviting your children to use other words that are made up of two short words – for example: bubble+gum, rain+coat, play+ground, butter+fly, rain+drop, sun+rise, cell+phone.
- Ask your children to find two of the same kind of object – for example: two forks, two shoes, two keys, two sticks. Each time they come back with the two objects, point to the objects and say, for example, “Double-double, two forks” or “Double-double, two shoes”.
