# Malunga nesicengcelezo

## About the rhyme

This rhyme is about a donkey that is complaining about the hard work that it's asked to do, like carrying heavy bags on its back.

## Imisebenzi

- Nikunye nabantwana bakho, linganisani iidonki zithwele imithwalo emqolo. Guqani ngamadolo nigaqe nibelege imiqamelo (nisenza iingxowa).
- Khangelani iphondo leMpuma Koloni kwimephu nincokole ngokuba iphi. Umzekelo: "Ingaba sihlala kwiphondo leMpuma Koloni? Ingaba bakhona abantu esibaziyo abahlala khona? Ikude kakhulu? Singaya ngantoni khona ... ngedonki? Ingathatha ixesha elingakanani loo nto?"
- Bakhe baya abantwana bakho kwiphondo leMpuma Koloni? Bacele/bakhuthaze ukuba bazobe ngohambo olo lwabo nangexesha labo ephondweni.

## Activities

- With your children, try being donkeys with bags on their backs. Walk around on your hands and knees, balancing cushions/pillows on your backs (as the "bags").
- Find the Eastern Cape on a map and talk about where it is. For example, "Do we live in the Eastern Cape? Do we know anyone who lives there? Is it far away? How could we get there ... on a donkey? How long do you think that would take?"
- Have your children ever travelled by road to the Eastern Cape or another place far from your home? Encourage them to draw pictures of their experiences.
