## Activities

- With your toddler, say the rhyme while you point to his/her nose.
- With older children, find the spices in the rhyme – or other ones – and smell them together. What words can you think of to describe the smells? Do you like any of the smells?
- Draw lots of faces, each with a nose in a different colour! Then repeat the rhyme replacing 'red' with one of those colours each time.
- Make a 'jolly red nose' to wear. Use part of an eggbox and paint it. Then make small holes on either side. Put some string or wool through each of the holes and tie it at the back of your head.
