

# Seasons



Spring is showery, flowery, bowery.

## About the rhyme

This short rhyme uses fun and interesting rhyming words to describe each of the seasons.

## Activities

- Close your eyes and listen to the rhyme, or say it together. Which colour does each season make you think of? If you could be one of the seasons, which one would you be? Make crowns to wear to represent the season each of you would like to be.
- Try to think of an action for each word used in the rhyme to describe the different seasons. Then say the rhyme together using the actions.
- Play “word-snap”. Let everyone choose their favourite word in the rhyme and write it on a piece of paper. When everyone has finished, hold up and say your favourite words at the same time. If any of you have the same favourite word, shout, “SNAP!”
