About the rhyme

This call-and-response Setswana-Afrikaans rhyme is about a train. The children line up with their hands on each other's shoulders or waists to make a train. Then the words of the rhyme are said with the children making the sound of the train in response to the adult. The last two responses by the children are in Afrikaans while the rest of the rhyme is in Setswana:

- Adult: Terena ... (*A train ...*)
Children: tšhutšhu (*choo-choo*)
Adult: Ya banyana ... (*For young children ...*)
