About the rhyme

This well-known nursery rhyme about a little star in the night sky can be sung or said.

Activities

- After you have said or sung the last line of the rhyme, encourage your children to 'become' something like a shooting star whizzing across the night sky, a tiny bright sparkly star or a dull gloomy star that doesn't want to move. Try exploring all of these.
- Play 'twinkle star' statues. Take turns singing/saying the rhyme and stopping at different places. Every time the person saying the rhyme stops, the other one 'becomes' a sparkly, twinkling star. Then point to each other with pretend magic wands (a stick, a leaf or just a finger) to continue with the rhyme.
- Do star jumps together!
