Activities

- Wash the dishes together with your children! (Use a chair to help them reach the sink, if you need to.) Or, fill a plastic bucket with soapy water and give your children some non-breakable kitchen items to wash for you.
- Together, draw different fish on paper, in sand or with water outside – big fish, small fish, round fish, thin fish, and fish with one colour or many colours! Talk together about the fish and, next to each one, write down what they name the fish and/or says about it. Afterwards, if your children are interested, together find all the 'f' letters in what you have written.
